- Retain factory parts for future use.





Refer to Figure A for Steps 1-3.

- Step 1: Loosen both clamps on the Sprintex intake tube.
- Step 2: Disconnect the Temperature sensor located on the bottom of the intake tube.
- Step 3: Remove the intake tube from the vehicle



Refer to Figure B for Steps 4-6.

- Step 4: Disconnect the CCV hose from the top of the OE airbox.
- Step 5: Remove the OE housing from the vehicle by lifting straight upward on the box.
- Step 6: Remove the two clamps from the radiator shroud that are securing the coolant overflow line.





Refer to Figure C for Steps 7-9.

- Step 7: Remove the temp sensor from the Sprintex intake tube.
- Step 8: Install the grommet, temp sensor adaptor, and temp sensor into the new aFe intake as shown.
- Step 9: Use Teflon tape to wrap the 1/8 NPT plug. Use this plug to seal the port on the side of the intake tube.

NOTE: The 1/8 NPT port on the side of the tube can be utilized for water/methanol injection if desired. (Sold separately and not available from aFe POWER)



Refer to Figure D for Step 10.

Step 10: Locate the rubber grommets and sleeves from the OE intake tube, and install the two grommets into the aFe intake tube from the bottom side.





Refer to Figure E for Steps 11-13

- Step 11: Install the aFe air filter into the intake housing.
- Step 12: Place the large clamp over the housing, but do not tighten the clamps at this time.
- Step 13: Verify that all three factory rubber grommets are in place on the battery tray, then install the aFe housing into the vehicle.



Refer to Figure F for Steps 14-19.

- Step 14: Place the coupling and the two smaller clamps over the throttle body.
- Step 15: Install the new aFe intake tube into the vehicle by inserting the large end of the tube into the filter and then aligning the smaller end of the tube with the coupler at the throttle body.
- Step 16: Route the coolant overflow line on top of the fan shroud so that it does not hang down near the fan.
- Step 17: Use the two OE screws from the intake to secure the intake tube to the fan shroud. The coolant overflow line can be tucked just underneath the two mounting tabs on the tube to secure it in place.
- Step 18: Reconnect the temp sensor harness to the sensor on the intake tube.
- Step 19: Connect the CCV hose to the port on the side of the aFe intake tube.





Refer to Figure G for Step 20.

Step 20: Tighten all clamps at this time. Your installation is now complete.

NOTE: Check all bolts, clamps, and hose connections after 100-200 miles.
